Music Production for Video Games

Wednesday 22 - Friday 24 July, 9.30am - 3.30pm

Age 11 to 18 No experience needed

Course Details

- A three day music technology course focusing on writing music for video games!
- Students will use Cubase software to write their own compositions inspired by their favourite video games, learning how to create complex soundscapes with virtual instruments
- The course will delve into how video game music is created and how much of an impact it has on the feel of a game
- Each student will have the opportunity to have their work showcased on a showreel to be shared on the Berkshire Maestros Facebook page

What you will learn

Students will leave the course with an excellent understanding of using a professional digital audio workstation to create original music using MIDI and virtual instruments. These skills are easily transferrable to GCSE and A Level and serve as an excellent lead on to Berkshire Maestros Music Production Lessons with Rockschool Grades.

Course Details

- A three day live band workshop focusing on preparing the students for a live stream concert on Friday afternoon
- Students will be led by an established Soundstage tutor for the duration of the course, helping to conduct and mould them into a fully functioning band, performing a variety of songs in a range of musical styles
- We are looking to select students at a Grade 6 plus level for this very special one-off course that will specifically require a balanced combination of singers, and guitarists, plus one each of keyboards, bass and drums (maximum of eight)
- Students will be offered sheet music and song charts to help aid their journey through the course.

What you will learn

Students will leave this course with a great understanding of working with fellow musicians in a high pressured band environment, with a deadlined performance. The level of musicianship will be high and students will learn valuable tips for on stage techniques. Members of this band may form a regular ensemble in September, with the possibility of participating in our largest events.
